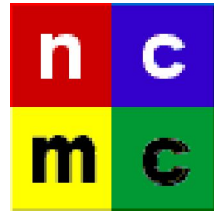

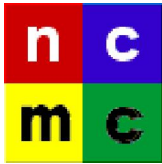
This year the NCMC History Section is offering two scholarships to the conference. Recipients are responsible for their own transportation, room, meals not covered by the registration fee, and special session charges.

The application below must be received by 5:00 p.m. January 22, 2010. The History Section Committee will meet shortly afterward and contact all of the applicants with scholarship award information on January 29. All applications must be submitted electronically; paper submissions will not be considered. You will be sent an e-mail confirmation when your application is received.

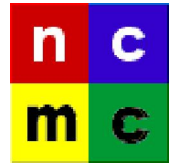
